**Dear Zhanseit Kanseituly!**

The Non-Profit Organisation “Eurasian Centre for Accreditation and Quality Assurance in Higher Education and Health Care” (hereinafter – ECAQA) hereby informs you of the decision of the ECAQA Accreditation Council dated 30 June 2025, Minutes No. 5, to accredit the bachelor’s and residency educational programmes of the NJSC “Al-Farabi Kazakh National University” (hereinafter – KazNU), listed below, for a period of five (5) years each, on the condition of a follow-up visit in May 2027 to the Faculty of Medicine and Healthcare by an ECAQA expert commission consisting of two accreditation experts and one observer from ECAQA. The purpose of this visit is to assess the implementation of the recommendations of the External Expert Commission regarding the improvement of the residency programmes, and to evaluate such parameters as: the adequacy of the student cohort enrolled in the residency programmes, the staffing of teaching faculty for each of the 22 newly accredited residency programmes, and the completeness of the educational and methodological materials.

KazNU will not incur any additional financial expenses related to the organisation of this ECAQA expert visit, as it is part of the post-accreditation monitoring process.

Enclosed with this letter are the recommendations of the External Expert Commission for the improvement of the educational programmes (Annex 1) and the original accreditation certificates for the above-mentioned educational programmes in three languages (Annex 2).

The External Expert Commission Reports and the decision of the Accreditation Council will be published in the international quality assurance registers EQAR-DEQAR, Asia-Pacific Register for Quality Assurance in Education (APQR-DAQAR), and on the ECAQA official website in the “Reestr” section: <https://www.ecaqa.org/en/reestr-en>.

Information on the accreditation of the above-mentioned educational programmes of KazNU will also be included in the Unified Higher Education Platform (UHEP) Register of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Details on the accredited educational programme 6B10114 – Medicine will be submitted to the WFME Portal, as ECAQA is a recognized accrediting agency of the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME).

In accordance with the accreditation process, post-accreditation monitoring will be carried out by ECAQA over a five-year period until June 2030 and will include the annual submission of a report on the implementation of the recommendations of the External Expert Commission.
